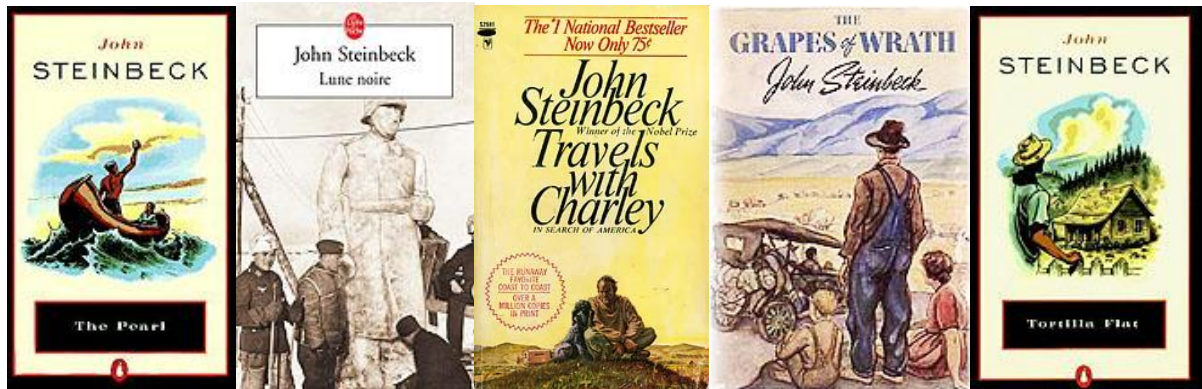


CCCTE PRESENTS
